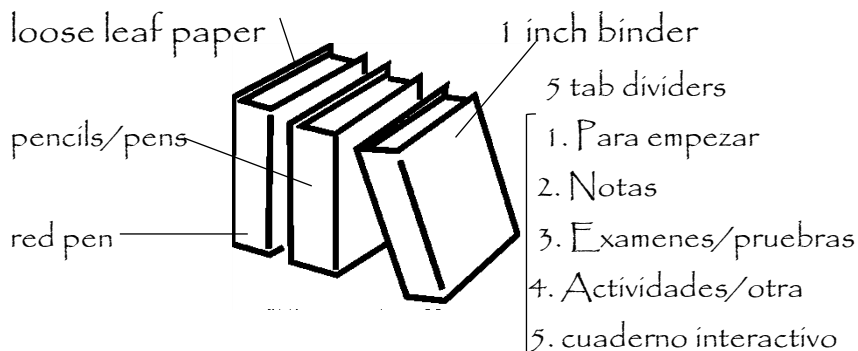

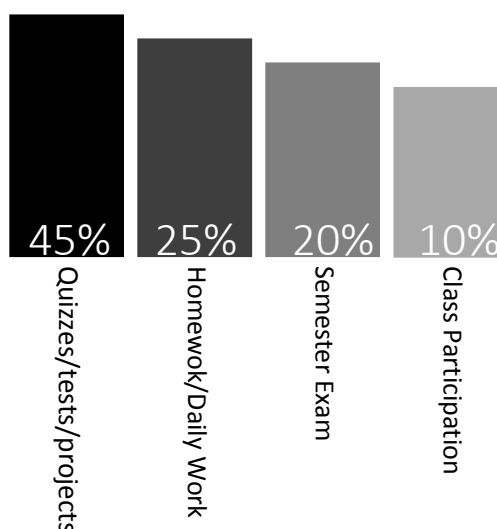
For the classroom: 5th Hour: 2 packages of note cards

COURSE DESCRIPTION

After a brief review of some Spanish I, Spanish II provides a continued emphasis on the ability to understand and use the Spanish language. The study of Spanish grammar and vocabulary is continued, enhancing the student's skills in reading, writing, listening, and speaking, and involving more difficult Spanish selections. The study of Spanish customs and culture is also central to this second-level program. Our curriculum aligns to the Oklahoma PASS and to the World Languages National Standards (ACTFL). 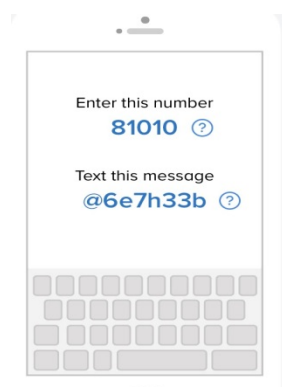

Quizzes/Tests: Quizzes will occur throughout the semester. To stay properly prepared, students should review nightly and pay attention in class. There will be no surprises as to the information and curriculum. You will have a test at the end of most units. Tests will include textbook material, supplemental readings, and supplemental notes given in class.

Late Work: Students who turn in their work late will receive only HALF CREDIT. If turning in your work late becomes a habit, you will find yourself in detention, and your parents will be contacted.

What if I'm absent? Upon returning to class, check the absent work bucket and with the teacher at a time that will not disrupt class instruction for any work she may have for you from the previous day(s).

Make-Up Policy: District policy will be followed for assignments turned in after the due date as a result of EXCUSED absences (days missed plus a day for each) (Not to exceed one week). School activity absences require students to turn in assignments and/or take quizzes PRIOR to absence. ALWAYS speak with the teacher prior to a school activity absence. Zeros are placed in the gradebook as placeholders until the assignment(s) or quiz is made up.

Homework/Daily Work: Homework, usually including workbook assignments, readings, and worksheets from each chapter, is assigned often - sometimes daily. Binder checks will occur often.

Class Participation: In order to improve your skills, we will be doing activities daily in class that require you to use the language. This is the most vital part of class! Participation grades are given weekly and are based on everything from completing your bell ringer exercises, to having your materials in class, to using the language in appropriate activities. This will be discussed further in class.

Semester Tests: The final exam is comprehensive and covers material from the beginning of the semester.

Academic Integrity: Cheating in any form will result in a zero (0) on that particular assignment/test as well as disciplinary actions. Plagiarism is considered cheating.

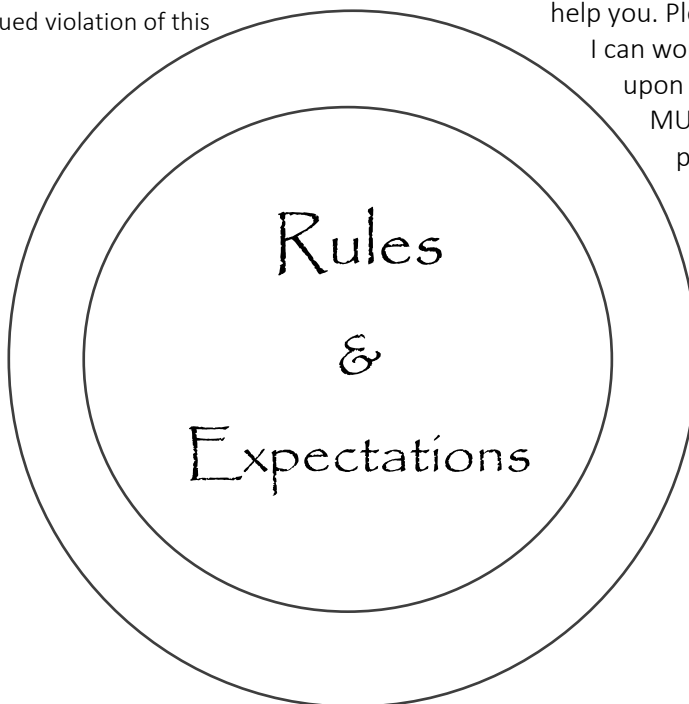
