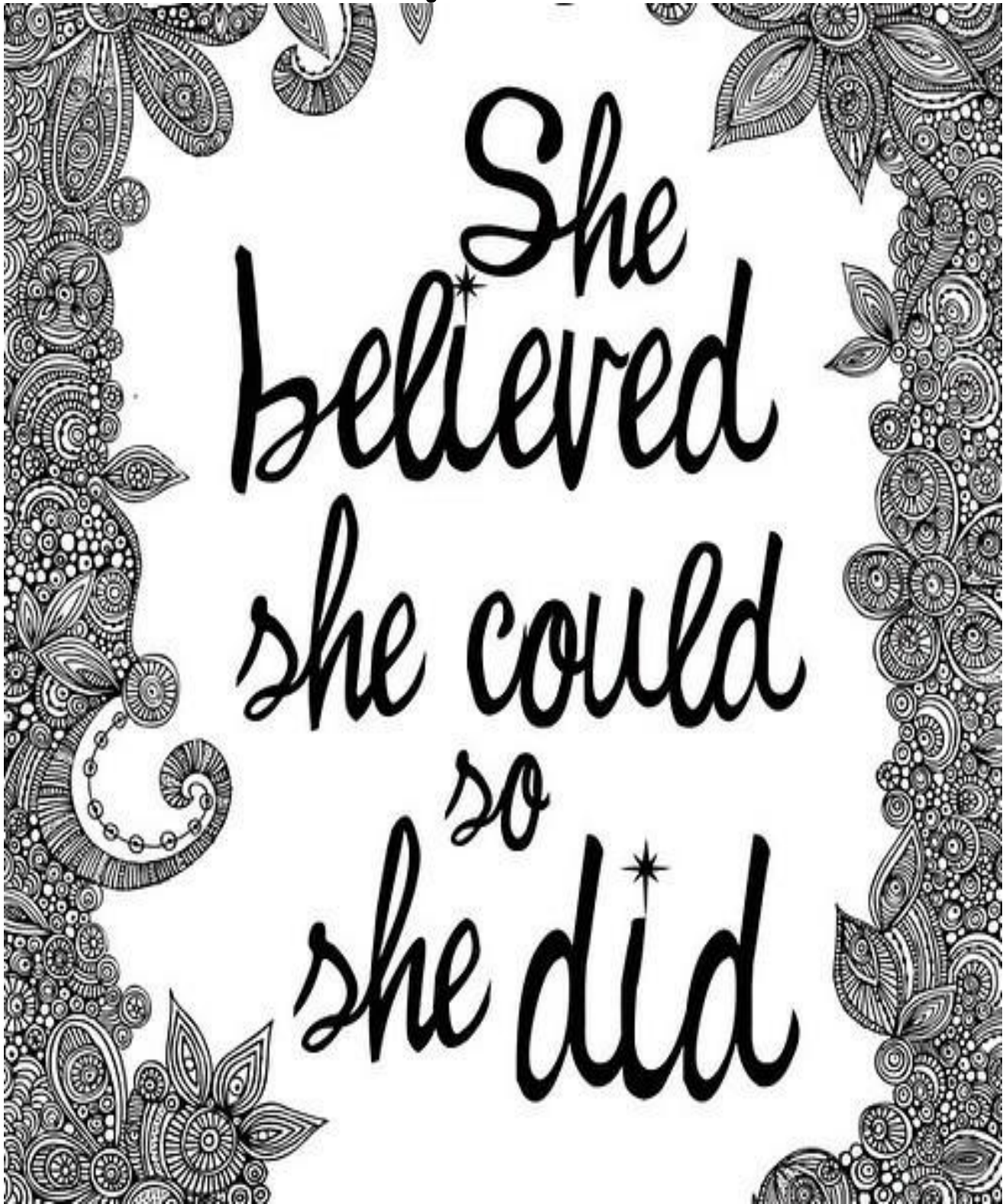

IN-PERSON TRYOUT GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Closed tryout.
2. Try out in the large gym in groups of 8.
3. Results are posted as soon as possible on Santa F's website.
4. Wear black tank. No graphics. Plain.
5. Wear black leggings.
6. Wear dance (jazz) shoes or half soles.
7. Secure hair including bangs in a ponytail or bun.
8. Apply appropriate "stage" makeup if desired.
9. No jewelry.
10. Three judges score.
11. Up to 24 athletes will be on Varsity Pom
12. Up to 12 athletes will be on Freshman Pom
13. Underclassmen will be assigned to JV events.
14. Additional information will be delivered with the clinic dance, band song and chant.
15. Refer to the Edmond Public Schools District Cheer & Pom Contract for district try-out guidelines and requirements.
16. Once the application process is complete, your name will go on the list to receive the virtual information.
17. Check your school email periodically for information and updates.

GENERAL INFORMATION

COACH

1. Responsible for schedules.
2. Responsible for grades.
3. Responsible for teaching leadership skills.
4. Responsible for working with athletes to find suitable solutions for challenges.
5. Responsible for maintaining a fair and equitable program.

PARENT EXPECTATIONS

1. Collaborate with other parents, athletes, coaches, and administration.
2. Support the decisions of the coach and administrators.
3. Access and use the proper chain of command starting with the coach, athletic director, assistant principal, principal, and finally school board.
4. Accountability for financial obligations throughout the school year.
5. Respect and support the athlete's time commitment.
6. Support your athlete in activities and responsibilities.
7. Understand and support your athlete in this physically and emotionally demanding sport.
8. Understand Pom can carry a risk of physical injury.
9. Understand that violations to the District or Santa Fe contract can lead to temporary or permanent suspension from the team.

TEAM MEMBER GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

1. Promote school spirit and unity, support, and encourage student body involvement at sporting events and various school activities.
2. Provide half time entertainment at sporting events as well as responsibilities at other events.
3. Demonstrate unity through uniforms, hair, earrings, socks, shoes, etc.
4. Practice respect to self and others.
5. Be a team player.
6. Use positive words and actions.
7. Be a positive role model.
8. Always demonstrate good leadership qualities.
9. Illustrate loyalty, cooperation and positive attitudes to self, team, student body, parents, coaches, administration, the universe, etc.

CLASS AND SCHEDULED PRACTICE RULES

1. Be prompt.
2. Be prepared.
3. Be respectful.
4. Members dress out daily unless specified otherwise by the coach/head captain.
5. Practice begins 10 minutes after the tardy bell.
6. When a team member is absent from practice, it is the athlete's responsibility to learn the missed instruction prior to the next practice.
7. If a member is ineligible for 3 consecutive weeks, the member will be removed from Pom.

GAME CONDUCT

1. Be punctual at games / bus.
2. Be prepared for restroom breaks before the game and during half-time.
3. Be conscious to remain in formation.
4. Be attentive to the captain(s).
5. Be attentive to the game.
6. Be attentive to band songs, PA songs, etc.
7. Ineligible athlete cannot attend games or wear their uniform on game days. Suggestion: Use the time to study to improve the grade.

GAME, EVENT, AND PRACTICE MISSES

The earlier the better; however, misses for a game or event will be given no later than 24 hours prior to the practice or event by text message or email.
