What can I do now to help my student start transitioning to high school?

- Help them learn study skills-keeping a planner; using their phone to store dates and other important information.
- Start setting boundaries on social media, gaming, and phone time
 - Teach them how to send an appropriate email
- Start teaching them how to advocate for themselves even if it is by email.
 - Talk to your students' current teachers about recommendations for IA classes or electives.
- Part of the transition to high school is less peer mediation with adults and more focus on academics. Start working with your students on problem solving within peer groups.
- Get them involved with something that energizes them and encourages leadership skills!
